Our newsletter this time around is a brief update on where the project is at and heartfelt thanks to all of those who support our work in bringing the birds back to the Tennyson Inlet Islands.

A letter from the Chairman



Another year has passed and we have all learnt first hand how disruptive COVID- 19 is. Few things are certain; the 'old normal' is not the 'new normal'......and at some time in the near future we will all catch COVID-19, but hopefully the systems will be in place to ensure ourselves and our health system can handle it.

Meanwhile, life on the islands, keeps improving. Bird counts continue to increase and demonstrate that our A24 traps are having the desired effect. Of course there is always room for improvement and we are working on this; mainly by adding more traps to increase the coverage. While six monthly service intervals of the A24 traps makes life far simpler and less demanding, we are going reduce the service interval to 4 months (meaning we head out to check them 3 times a year). Research in other trapping programmes has shown that 4 monthly replacement of the gas and bait keeps them closer to 100% effective.

Thanks to the subscriptions and donations we have received we been able to purchase a year's supply of the consumables required to keep the A24s operating to their best ability. We even have two different flavours of bait available so that can lure even the fussiest rats!

We have also recently purchased twelve Victor rat traps so we can set up some tracking tunnels to better monitor where on the island we have higher concentrations of rats.
